Subj: Monthly Report

During the month of February, 2017 the Fire Department responded to a total of 197 alarms for service. There were 149 calls for the Rescue service of those 48 were for Advanced Life Support 40 for Basic Life Support. In this group there were 29 Refused Treatment and there were 8 where no aid was rendered. During the month there were 21 times that Mutual Aid was called to assist and there were also 18 times that Barrington was called to assist outside communities.

There were 79 alarms for Fire related calls. There was one Residential fires and there were no Business fire and there were no Vehicle fires. There were also 14 Accidental calls and 10 Fire Alarm system malfunctions.

There were 14 alarms classified as Other Alarms that include investigations for smoke, wires and transformers, gas leaks and citizen assists.

Non-Emergency activities included Fire Inspections to commercial, public and private buildings and smoke and carbon monoxide inspections in residences that are ready for resale. Plan review of construction projects also occur as needed during the month.

Rescue Mutual Aid is closely monitored on a monthly basis and during February, 2017 Barrington requested aid from East Providence 3 times for a twelve month total of 106 calls. Barrington supplied Mutual Aid to East Providence 16 times for a twelve month total of 123 calls.

Rescue billing receipts for the month of February, 2017 was \$49,984 and for Smoke Detector Inspections and Construction Plan Review the total was \$987.
